

Skymark and Airbus reached a basic agreement on Introduction of A380

Skymark Airlines and Airbus (headquartered in Toulouse, France) reached a basic agreement on introduction of Airbus A380 (hereafter A380). Skymark plans to sign a contract with Airbus in the next spring for introducing six A380s (including two options). The first A380 is scheduled for delivery in 2014 and the aircraft will be operated in major international routes.

Skymark will offer low cost fares to the public and increase travelers' convenience by introducing the A380 for major trunk long-haul routes while further developing the efficiency of its business operations. The A380 provides excellent cabin comfort and the cutting-edge technologies, offering passengers the best flying experience.

Skymark will further improve its quality of services and establish a wide range network that would best meet the expectations of passengers.
